Rules of Conduct

1. Students exhibiting poor behavior, lack of preparation, tardiness or absence from rehearsals will be dismissed from the chorus.
2. Students are to remain reasonably quiet at all times in the hotel rooms, both day and night. Television and radio broadcasts are to be played at low levels at all times.
3. Students are to wear Festival Badges at all times when outside the hotel rooms.
4. Hotel room doors should be locked at all times.
5. Curfew of students will be 10:30 p.m. each night of the festival. The curfew means that students must be in their rooms and not leave them after the hour of curfew. It is recommended that you get plenty of rest to be prepared for the rigorous rehearsals and to keep your voice in excellent condition for singing.
6. Possession or use of illegal materials, alcoholic beverages, or narcotics in any form is prohibited.
7. All cell phones and other electronic devices must be turned off during rehearsals.
8. Boys are not allowed to visit the girls' rooms; girls are not allowed to visit the boys' rooms. If it is necessary to make an exception, a chaperone must be present.
9. No practicing or playing of instruments in the hotel room after 10:00 p.m. on any night.

ALL REGULATIONS MUST BE ADHERED TO RIGIDLY. ANY INFRINGEMENT OR VIOLATION OF RULES WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC DISMISSAL FROM ALL ACTIVITIES OF THE FESTIVAL AND A REQUEST THAT THE STUDENT BE IMMEDIATELY SENT HOME.
